Europe has an ambitious vision, a vision of a carbon neutral future, which integrates energy intensive industries as well as the construction sector and its value chain. Cement and concrete are at the heart of solutions turning that vision into reality.

Five years ago, the European cement industry published its Low Carbon Roadmap outlining how we can reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 32% (compared with 1990 levels) by 2050 with conventional technologies and potentially by 80% if breakthrough technologies become widely available.

Now we take stock of where we are on our journey to 2050 and explore additional avenues to accelerate our progress and the transition towards our objectives.
