## CO<sub>2</sub> COSTS IN CEMENT SOME CALCULATIONS

- Cement production costs 2021 estimated at 46 58 euros/ton (excluding CO<sub>2</sub> costs).
  (Based on literature information and inflation correction)
- 2. <u>At an EU ETS price of 55 Euros/EUA, CO<sub>2</sub> costs for the average EU27 cement plant are estimated at 4.42 euros/ton, corresponding to 8 10% of total costs</u>

This is based on the difference between the emissions performance with subtraction of the free allowances at 100% of the benchmark level

3. <u>At an EU ETS price of 90 Euros/EUA, CO<sub>2</sub> costs for the</u> <u>average EU27 cement plant are estimated at 7.23 euros/ton,</u> <u>corresponding to 12-15% of total costs</u>

  - Production costs: "The average EU production cost is around €48 per tonne (2012 official data), but within the sample, the costs per tonne range within the EU from €35 (minimum) to €73 (maximum). Main cost components are the energy costs, raw materials, maintenance costs and labour costs; these costs vary per kiln and per region."
  - Market prices: "Industry representatives indicate that cement is currently (2017) sold for an average ex-factory price around € 60 per tonne, although this may vary significantly."
